

Grand Junction, Colorado, April 26, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeek, Rankin, Carson, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of April 21st were read and approved.

The reports of the City Weigher and Fire Chief having been examined and approved, by the Mayor, the same were, on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, accepted and ordered placed on file.

The reports of the Commissioner of Public Affairs, Commissioner of Water and Sewers, Commissioner of Highways, and City Treasurer having been examined and approved by the auditor, the same were, on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin,

accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the City Health Officer was submitted and read, and on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The quarterly report of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty was submitted and read. On motion of Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the report was referred to the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies.

The bond of A. O. Shaff, as garbage collector, having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, the same was, on motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Commissioner of Highways be authorized and instructed to rent 21 inches of ditch water from Henry Rhone and five inches from Fred Cee at \$3.00 per inch for the irrigating season.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioner voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and it was so ordered.
