

Grand Junction, Colorado, May 12, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeck, Rankin, Carson, Helmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 5th were read and approved.

The monthly report of the City Weigher was submitted and read, and on motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the same was referred to the Mayor.

The reports of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty and the City Clerk having been examined and approved by the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, the same were on motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Carson, accepted and ordered placed on file.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning the Caretaker at the Kannah Creek Intake and the Foreman of Construction and Repair of the City Water and Sewer Systems, and Fixing the Salaries of Certain Employees," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized and instructed to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City with Henry N. Patterson for the use of Palmer Park for <sup>Seasons</sup> two ~~years~~, with permission to remove engine and pump from the said premises at the expiration of the said period.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the Council adjourned.
