

Grand Junction, Colorado, June 9, 1910.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeck, Rankin, Carson, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 2d were read and approved.

The following bills having been approved by heads of departments and audited, were read by the Clerk:

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the bills as read be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the several amounts.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

Charles A. Vierse having applied for a license to carry on the business of an employment agent for the balance of the current fiscal year, it was moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the license be granted to Mr. Vierse to the end of the current fiscal year upon the payment of \$17.50 to the city treasurer.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

A committee, consisting of A. C. Parsens, J. E. Meerhead and Mrs. D. Hepkirk, appeared before the Council and asked the city to provide for the renting of a suitable room to be fitted up and used for a public rest room.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, that a special committee, consisting of the Mayor and the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, be appointed to take up the matter of paying the rental for a public rest room and the availability of city funds for the purpose, and make report to the Council at its next regular meeting.

The motion carried.

On the petition of F. M. Campbell, J. A. Osborne, Halsey Jeffers, J. W. Davis, H. S. Manning, and H. W. Verbeck, submitting a proposed ordinance concerning the purchasing, owning and operating electric light, power and gas works by the City of Grand Junction, the City Clerk and City Attorney, to whom said petition had been referred, reported that the same was in proper form and was signed by the requisite number of electors.

The proposed ordinance was then taken up for consideration by the Council and read by the Clerk.

Commissioner Verbeck having moved and Commissioner Rankin seconded that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication, it was moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, as a substitute motion, that the proposed ordinance be laid on the table for one week and that consideration of the same be made the special order of business at the next regular meeting of the Council.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows:
Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, no; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the substitute motion carried, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the Council adjourned until Friday, June 12, at 10 o'clock a. m.
