Meved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the request of Mr. Mathews and others be granted and the petition returned.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, that the ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The metien being put, upon call of rell, the Cemmissioners veted as fellows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the metion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

Mayer Cherrington and Commissioner Verbeck, special committee on the matter of paying the rental for a public rest room, made verbal report, and while endersing the movement for same, on account of the lack of funds reported adversely to making an appropriation for same.

On metien of Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the report of the committee was accepted and the committee discharged.

C. P. McCary, who had presented the petition protesting against the passage of a proposed ordinance in reference to the purchase and operation of electric light and gas works, asked that the petition be returned to him.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the request of Mr. McCary be granted and the petition signed by him and others be returned.

The metien carried.

On metien of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commisssioner Verbeck, the Council adjourned.
