

Grand Junetien, Celerade, June 16, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junetien convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeck, Rankin, Carsen, Helmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 9th and adjourned session of June 12th were read and approved.

The petition of C. P. McCary and others, protesting against the passage by the Council of a proposed ordinance concerning the purchase and operation of electric light and gas plants by the city of Grand Junetien, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the petition was laid on the table to later in the afternoon, of this meeting.

J. B. Mathews, J. W. Van Hern, John Wolf, A. H. Ricker and B. W. Vedder, representing the signers of the petition submitting a proposed ordinance in reference to the purchase and operation of electric light and gas works by the city of Grand Junetien, appeared before the Council and made a formal withdrawal of said petition with said proposed ordinance and asked that said petition be returned to them.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the request of Mr. Mathews and others be granted and the petition returned.

The motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Carsen, that the bills as read be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the several amounts.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carsen, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning the Appraisal and Valuation of the Electric Light, Power and Gas Plants now Operated under Franchises from the City of Grand Junction," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, that the ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carsen, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

Mayor Cherrington and Commissioner Verbeck, special committee on the matter of paying the rental for a public rest room, made verbal report, and while endorsing the movement for same, on account of the lack of funds reported adversely to making an appropriation for same.

On motion of Commissioner Carsen, seconded by Commissioner Helmburg, the report of the committee was accepted and the committee discharged.

C. P. McCary, who had presented the petition protesting against the passage of a proposed ordinance in reference to the purchase and operation of electric light and gas works, asked that the petition be returned to him.

Moved by Commissioner Verbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the request of Mr. McCary be granted and the petition signed by him and others be returned.

The motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, the Council adjourned.
