

Grand Junction, Colorado, September 29, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Verbeek, Rankin, Carson, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of September 23d and adjourned session of September 25th were read and approved.

The report of S. R. Schaeffer, certified public accountant, on the examination and audit of the books and accounts of the City of Grand Junction for the first half of the current fiscal year, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Verbeek, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On the application of the Winston Brothers Company to use water from the city system, Commissioner Carson, to whom the application had been referred, reported favorably and recommended that their request be granted.

Moved by Commissioner Carson, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the application of Winston Brothers Company to connect with the city system of pipes at the north end of the Seventh street line be granted, and that they be furnished water at the monthly meter rates.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows:

Cherrington, yea; Verbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Several of the persons appointed as judges and clerks of election for the special municipal election to be held October 1st having declined to serve, it was moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, that the following changes in the several election boards be made: In Precinct No. 9, that J. H. Schiesswohl be appointed a judge in place of Mrs. Emma Budelier; in Precinct No. 10, Frank Hall for clerk in place of Sadie Erickson; in Precinct No. 11, Mrs. Josephine Pearce for clerk in place of C. R. Leugh; in Precinct No. 12, Mrs. A. P. Drew for clerk in place of F. D. Price; in Precinct No. 16, Mrs. Bertha C. Welles for clerk in place of Ralph Todd.

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Council, and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Verbeck, the Council adjourned until Saturday, October 3d, at 10 o'clock a. m.
