

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 4, 1914.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carson, the Council adjourned until Friday, November 6, at 4 o'clock p. m.
