

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 16, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 10 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayer Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Carsen, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Verbeek.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Water Rents," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Carsen, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Carsen, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance levying a Special Assessment on all Lots or Tracts of Land in the City of Grand Junction Abutting on or having Access to Water Mains," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Carsen, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Carsen, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

On motion of Commissioner Carsen, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
