

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 17, 1914.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Carson, Helmburg. Absent: Commissioner Verbeck.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of November 10th and adjourned session of November 16th were read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Commissioner of Highways be authorized and instructed to purchase for his department 10,920 pounds of oats at \$1.60 per cwt.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Carson, yea; Helmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

The official bond of Charles E. Cherrington, Commissioner of Public Affairs, having been examined and approved by the City Attorney, the same was on motion of Commissioner Helmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, accepted and ordered placed on file.
