TALLY SHEET

We, the undersigned, acting as canvassing board, hereby certify that we have canvassed the returns of the municipal election held in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, on April 4th, 1939, and from the said canvas find the results to be as follows: that 248 ballots were cast in District "A"; that 235 ballots were cast in District "B"; that 262 ballots were cast in District "C"; that 264 ballots were cast in District "D"; and that 537 ballots were cast in District "E"; making a total number of 1546 ballots cast in all the Districts at said election.
