

✓ An Act-entitled
An Ordinance

Concerning Town Officers

Be it-ordained by the Board of
Trustees of the Town of Boones
Junction:

Town Attorney,

Sec 1st - Shall be the duty of the Town
Attorney to appear in behalf of the
Town in all suits and proceedings which
may be pending in any court-when in

The Town is a party, and, to give

his opinion upon all questions of law submitted to him by the Board of Trustees

Sec 2nd The Town attorney is hereby authorized to make or execute in the name of the Town of Grand Junction any affidavit or bond that may be necessary in any suit or proceeding wherein the Town is a party.

Sec 3rd The Town attorney shall receive such salary as the Board of Trustees may determine and his fees shall be as follows; (viz) There shall be allowed and taxed with the costs in a Justice's or Magistrate's Court - a fee of five dollars and in the District or County Court - a fee of Ten dollars for each day that he appears, and prosecutes any case in such County respectively; Provided that - the Town attorney shall not be entitled to the above fees unless judgment is rendered in favor of the Town, and the cost collected of defendant.

Sec 4th (Town Recorder)

The Town Recorder shall be keeper of the Town seal, and shall affix it to all instruments which are required to be attested by the Town seal; he shall have custody of, and safely keep all records and documents of the Board of Trustees,

Sec 5th It shall be the duty of the Town Recorder to record the proceedings of the Board of Trustees in books provided for that purpose, he shall countersign all warrants drawn on the Treasurer under the Town Seal, and render to the Board of Trustees a report of his transactions in his said office whenever required to do so and shall receive such salary as the Board of Trustees may determine and in place of license fees such extra compensation as would be just and equitable, to be determined by the Board of Trustees

(Town Treasurer)

Sec 6th

It shall be the duty of the Town Treasurer to receive and receipt for all moneys belonging to the Town he shall pay from the Treasury such sums of money as may be ordered paid by the Board of Trustees, and the warrants therefor shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Town Recorder and shall state for what purpose the money is appropriated, the particular fund or appropriation to which the same is chargeable and the person to whom payable, he shall keep the accounts separate from each others charging each fund with all payments and crediting it with all moneys received on account thereof, and upon all warrants payable out of any particular fund there shall

be legibly written the name of the fund out of which they are payable

Sec 7th The Treasurer shall keep a true and accurate account of all moneys belonging to the Town of Grand Junction and shall report to the Board of Trustees in writing once in each month all moneys received and paid out by him and all other business transacted by him during the month pertaining to his office

Sec 8th All warrants shall be paid by the Treasurer according to priority in the order in which the same are presented for payment; and whenever any warrant may be presented for payment, and the Treasurer shall not have funds in hand for the payment of the same it shall be his duty to indorse upon the face of such warrant the date of its presentation and from such date said warrant shall bear interest at the rate of Ten per cent per annum

Sec 9th The Town Treasurer shall fulfill such other requirements not herein expressly stated as are now or may hereinafter be provided by law and shall receive such compensation as the Board of Trustees shall determine, payable ~~quarterly~~ quarterly

Fees

SEC 10th Justices of the peace when performing duties and taking cognizance of cases arising under the ordinances of the Town of Grand Junction and Police Magistrates when the same are appointed shall charge and receive the same fees as are allowed for like services to Justices of the peace in the County of Gunnison by the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Colorado.

SEC 11th Officers not herein enumerated except the Mayor and members of the Board of Trustees shall receive such compensation for their service as may at any time be established by resolutions ordinances or order of the Board of Trustees, provided that the emoluments of no officer shall be increased or diminished during the term for which he shall have been elected or appointed.
