Our Ordinances

✓ To amend Section one of our Ordinance, entitled our Ordinance Concerning Dogs

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction

Sec I That Section one of our Ordinance entitled our Ordinance Concerning Dogs approved Sept-24th AD 1882 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows to wit:

That no dog shall be allowed to run at large within the limits of the Town unless the owner or keeper of any such dog shall before the first day of November of each year pay to the Town Recorder for the use of the Town the sum of three dollars for each and every dog and whelp and the sum of six dollars for each and every bitch owned or kept by each person and shall also place upon the neck of such dog a collar made of durable material, and upon the issuing of the proclamation of the Mayor as provided by Ordinance shall also cause the mouth of any such dog to be securely muzzled with a wire muzzle for such time as may be provided
