

An Ordinance to Provide for the
Planting of Trees, in the Parks and
along the Sidewalks in the Town
of Grand Junction

Be it ordained by the
Board of Trustees of the Town
of Grand Junction

Sec 1 That there shall be planted and
maintained along the sides of each
and every street in the Town of
Grand Junction, and in each
public Parks of said Town a suitable
number, and kind of Shade Trees
which said Trees shall be selected
by the City Forester and shall be
planted under his discretion

Sec 2 The cost of procuring, planting and
maintaining each of said Trees shall
be assessed as a specific Tax against
the lot in front of or along the side
of which the same may be planted
and shall be collected as is provided
for the collection of other Taxes,
provided that the owner of said
lot in the manner hereinafter
provided and under the direction
of the City Forester, procure plant
and maintain said Trees himself
at his option and at his own
expense

Sec 3 It shall be the duty of the Mayor
as soon hereafter as may be to appoint
a suitable and competent person to
act as forester whose duty it shall
be to select the Trees to be planted

Along Said Streets and in Said
Parks and to Superintend the Planting
and maintaining of the Same

Sec 4 It shall be the Duty of Each Lot
Owner, his agent or Attorney who
desires to procure and Plant Said
Trees in front of or along the
Said of his lot, or lots to give
notice of his intention to do so to
the forester within fifteen days
after the first publication of
this Ordinance upon giving Said
notice the Said lot-owner his agent
or Attorney shall under the directions
of the forester procure and Plant
Said Trees within fifteen days
after giving Said notice in
Each and Every Case where such
Notice is not given, it shall
be the duty of the forester to
procure and Plant such Trees in
the manner herein provided

Sec 5 If any Person shall willfully
breath harm upon in any
way or destroy any of Said Trees
or if any animal or animals
hatched or tied by him or
thruy, his orders shall in any
way remove or destroy any of
Said Trees he shall for each offence
be fined in a Sum not less
than one dollar nor more than
one hundred Dollars

Sec 10 The Parks which on the original
 Plat of the Town of Grand Junction
 is designated as Maple Park shall
 be hereafter known as Cottonwood
 Park, and shall be planted with
 Cottonwood Trees and the Park
 which on said Plat is designated
 as Cottonwood Park shall hereafter
 be known as Maple Park and shall
 be planted with Maple Trees

Chestnut and Walnut Parks
 shall respectively be planted with
 Chestnut and Walnut Trees
