Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate speed limit for the segment of 26 Road from Patterson Road to F 1/2 Rd. was conducted on September 16, 2014. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 6 section 615 Part 2 and Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 2003 Model Traffic Code, section 7B.15 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2009 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in his opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Speed Regulation:

A reduction in speed limit from 35 MPH to 30 MPH on 26 Rd. from Patterson Rd. to F 1/2 Rd. has been established.
