

An Ordinance

To Repeal Sec. 13 of an Ordinance
 Entitled an Ordinance concerning
 proceedings before Police Magistrates
 or Justices of the Peace for Fines
 and penalties—

Be it ordained by the Board of
 Trustees of Grand Junction:—

- Sec 1 The Section 13 of said Ordinance
 is hereby repealed and the
 following shall stand in
 lieu thereof as Sec 13:
 Every person against whom
 any penalty or fine shall
 be recovered, under the ordi-
 nances of the Town, who
 shall refuse or neglect to pay
 the same when demanded upon
 execution— and shall be com-
 mitted in default ~~to~~ to the
 Town Jail, or such other
 place as the Board may des-
 ignate, shall labor on the
 streets of Grand Junction, under
 the direction of the Town Marshal
 or the Street Commissioner, until
 such fine or penalty and costs
 thereof are fully paid— to be allow-
 ed at the rate of Two Dollars
 per day, exclusive of board, the
 day to consist of not less than
 eight nor more than Ten hours
 of faithful work, and if such
 person shall refuse to labor on
 said streets as aforesaid, or to com-
 ply with the directions of the Town
 Marshal, or the Street Commissioner,
 in relation thereto, such person

shall be confined in the said jail
 on a diet of bread and water
 for a period double the time
 in which such person might dis-
 charge his penalty, or fine by labor-
 ing on the streets as aforesaid, provided
 that such imprisonment shall not
 exceed ninety days—
