

# Dogs

An Ordinance  
 To amend Sec. 1 of an ordinance  
 entitled an Ordinance  
 Concerning Dogs—

Be it ordained by the Board of  
 Trustees of Grand Junction:—

~~Sec 1~~ of an ordinance entitled an  
 Ordinance concerning dogs be and  
 the same is hereby amended so  
 as to read as follows:—

That no dog shall be allowed  
 to run at large within the limits  
 of the town unless the owner  
 or keeper of any such dog shall  
 before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May of each  
 year pay to the Town Recorder  
 for the use of the Town the  
 sum of Two dollars and Fifty  
 cents for each and every dog  
 over six months old and the  
 sum of Five dollars for each  
 and every Bitch over six  
 months, and shall also place  
 upon the neck of such dog  
 a collar made of durable  
 material, and upon the issuing  
 of the proclamation of the  
 Mayor, as provided by ordi-  
 nance, shall also cause the  
 mouth of any such dog to be  
 securely muzzled with a wire  
 muzzle, for such time as may  
 be prescribed by the Mayor,  
 in said proclamation.

# Hoops

Sec 2 Whenever the Mayor of said Town shall apprehend hydrophobia in this Town - he shall issue his proclamation, requiring all person within the town, owning or keeping any dog, to confine the same for such time as he may designate; during which time it shall not be lawful for any such dog to run at large within the town, unless securely muzzled as aforesaid; and it shall be the duty of the Town Marshal to kill any dog found running at large within the Town during such time, unless muzzled as above provided, and the owner thereof shall forfeit and pay to the Town the sum of Five Dollars for each and every dog so found at large -

Sec 3 Any person who shall molest or hinder the Town Marshal in the discharge of the duty herein prescribed, shall forfeit and pay to the Town, not less than Five Dollars nor more than Twenty Five Dollars

Sec 4 If any person shall allow any bitch bitch or owned by him, to run at large while in heat, he shall forfeit and

pay to the Town Five Dollars and it shall be the duty of the town marshal to kill any bitch so found at large in the Town.

Sec 5 The Town Marshal shall receive the sum of One Dollar for each dog he may kill under the provisions of this Ordinance, provided he causes the same to be removed beyond the limits of the Town and buried; and it shall be the duty of the Marshal to have any dog so killed removed and buried as aforesaid.

Sec 6 It is hereby made the duty of all persons on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May in each year, to apply to the Town Recorder and make payment to him, as required in Sec. 1. of this Article; and it shall be the duty of said Recorder to issue a license to said owner or Keeper of any such dog for one year - and the Recorder shall keep a record of the persons so licensed.

Sec 7 Any person owning or keeping any such dog, who shall allow the same to run at large within the Town limits, without having first obtained a license, as provided for in this ordinance, shall forfeit and pay a penalty of Five Dollars for each offense

And any dog so found running at large, may be taken by the Marshal, or his deputy, to the pound, and confined therein, and after pasting two notices, one at the Mayor's office, and the other at the Post office, giving description of such dog, and stating that it is so impounded, for the period of three days, it shall be the duty of the Marshal, unless such dog is reclaimed, and One Dollar paid to him for expense and trouble in connection therewith, within said time to kill the same; provided any bitch found running at large, while in heat, may be killed as specified in Sec. 4. of this ordinance, without first impounding the same.

Sec 8 The word dog whenever used in this ordinance shall be construed to mean bitch as well as dog.

Sec 9 The Town Recorder shall furnish each person paying license as provided in Sec. 1. hereof with a numbered tag, which shall be securely fastened by person to the collar mentioned in said section, and the Recorder shall keep a record showing

to whom such license was issued  
and the number of tag furnished  
each person

Sec 10

The Town Marshal shall receive Fifty  
cents for collecting license for each  
dog for which he may collect  
license as provided in Sec 1.

Sec 11

All Ordinances or parts of  
Ordinances inconsistent herewith  
are hereby repealed.
