

# Levy of Taxes

An Ordinance concerning  
the Levy of Taxes for the fiscal  
year commencing April 1<sup>st</sup> 1883

Be it ordained by the Board  
of Trustees of the Town of  
Grand Junction:

That in order  
to defray the necessary expenses  
and liabilities of the Town of  
Grand Junction, for the fiscal  
year commencing April 1<sup>st</sup> A.D.  
1882, there be levied, and  
collected on the taxable prop-  
erty, real and personal, with-  
in the limits of said Town  
of Grand Junction the following  
taxes on each dollar of valu-  
ation of such taxable property  
to wit: First for ordinary  
town revenue, six mills, second  
for the purpose of sustaining  
and improving streets, alleys  
and crossings, fourteen mills—  
making a total tax of twenty  
mills on each dollar of valuation  
of taxable property within the  
limits of said Town.
