

## Vacation of Streets &c

An ordinance to provide for the vacation of certain streets, avenues and alleys in the Town of Grand Junction

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction—

Sec 1

Whereas, the right of way of the Denver & Rio Grande Railway embraces the following limits in the South Western corner of Sec. 14—T<sup>h</sup>. 1, S. R. 1 W. 11<sup>th</sup> Principle Mer., to wit: Commencing at the South West Corner of said Section, and running thence East along the South line of said Section 734 ft—thence Northwesterly to a point on the East line of said Section 842 ft North of the said South West Corner of Sec 14; thence South 842 ft to the place of beginning. That so much of the West ends of South & Pitkin Avenues and of the South end of First St. as lie within the above described limits are hereby vacated together with all parts of alleys lying within said limits.

Sec 2 And, whereas, the right of way of the Denver & Rio Grande Railway embraces the following limits in the South East corner of Sec. 14 in the 1. S. R. 1 W. 11<sup>th</sup> Principle Mer., to wit: Commencing at a point on the South line of said Section 994 ft west of the South East Corner of said Section and

running thence East along the South line of said section 678 ft. thence North Easterly to a point on the East line of said section - 94 ft North from the South East Corner of the same - Thence North along the East line of said section 710 ft. Thence South Westerly to the point of beginning -

That so much of the East end of South Avenue together with so much of any alley or alleys as lie within the above described limits, are hereby vacated
