

An Ordinance amending an Ordinance  
concerning Licenses:

Be it ordained by The Board of Trustees of The Town of Grand Junction, That the Ordinance Concerning licenses be and the same is hereby amended, by adding the following.

Section 1. Any person applying for any license or permit to conduct or carry on any business, or for any other purpose, shall pay The Town Treasurer, the amount specified in this Ordinance for the business specified, in cash, or lawful money of the United States therefor: and The Treasurer shall issue to the person so applying duplicate receipts, which shall be dated and numbered, and shall specify the amount and the purpose for which the money was received, and upon the presentation of one of the receipts to The Recorder, he shall issue to the person or persons therein named a license for the purpose therein specified.

Section 2. One of the said duplicate receipts shall be retained by The recorder and the same shall be registered by him in a book kept for that purpose, and shall be filed and kept by him as his voucher.

Section 3. The Recorder shall receive for the issuance of each liquor

or saloon license, the sum of One Dollar, and for each other license, excepting dog license, fifty cents, to be paid in all cases by the person, to whom such license is issued.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
