

# Amendment to Dog Ordinance

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction,

Sec<sup>1st</sup> That an ordinance entitled an Ordinance concerning Dogs passed and approved June 28<sup>th</sup> 1883 be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following.

Sec<sup>2</sup> It shall be the duty of the Marshal Deputy Marshall or any Policeman of the Town to kill all unlicensed ~~dog~~ vicious dogs found running at large within the limits of the Town, and it shall be lawful for any citizen to kill such unlicensed or vicious dogs by any means other than shooting

Sec<sup>3</sup> A vicious dog is hereby defined to be a dog that bites persons upon the streets or any public place or a dog that runs and bites or barks at horses being ridden or driven through the streets. It shall be unlawful for a vicious dog to run at large and such a dog shall be liable to be killed as provided for in the preceding section, notwithstanding such dog has been licensed passed and adopted Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1884
