AN ORDINANCE.

Annual Appropriation Bill for the Fiscal Year Beginning April 1st, A. D. 1886, and Ending March 31st, A. D. 1887.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction:

EECTION 1. The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the town of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of April, A. D. 1886, and ending on the thirty-first day of March, A. D. 1887, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force, the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00).

2nd. For the purpose of sustaining and improving streets, alleys, crossings and ditches, the sum of eighteen hundred dollars (\$1800.00).

3rd. For establishing and maintaining a fire department, including the purchase of implements and machinery for the same, and the construction of wells, cisterns and reservoirs, and procuring water for irrigation, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).

4th. For the general fund the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000.00).
