An Ordinance.

Annual Appropriation Bill for the Fiscal Year beginning April 1st, A. D. 1887, and ending March 31st, A. D. 1888.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the

Town of Grand Junction:

SECTION 1. The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1st, 1887, and ending March 31st, 1888, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force, the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars

(\$1,400.00.)

2nd. For the purpose of sustaining and improving streets, alleys, crossings, ditches and public parks and the procuring of water for irrigation, the sum of Nineteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,900.00).

3rd. For the General Fund, the sum of Seven-

teen Hundred Dollars (\$1,700.00).
