

## An Ordinance

An Ordinance entitled An Ordinance to Amend Article 1 Chapter VI of the Revised Ordinances of the Town of Grand Junction

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction Colo.:

That article 1 of Chapter VI of the Revised Ordinances of the Town of Grand Junction be and the same is amended by adding the following as Section 12 of said Article:

Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person to sink excavate or dig any privy vault or cesspool within the Corporate limits of the town without having previously obtained a permit in writing so to do from the town Marshal or Street Commissioner; and said vault or cesspool shall not in any case be less than eight feet in depth from the surface of the ground and shall be securely boxed up on the sides and ends so as to effectually prevent the caving of the earth.

Any persons violating the provisions of this section shall on conviction be fined in any sum not less than five dollars or more than twenty five dollars for each offense.

## AN ORDINANCE.

## An Ordinance Entitled An Ordinance to Amend Article 1, Chapter VI of the Revised Ordinances of the Town of Grand Junction.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction, Colo.:

That Article 1 of Chapter VI of the Revised Ordinances of the town of Grand Junction be and the same is amended by adding the following as Section 12 of said article:

SECTION 12. It shall be unlawful for any person to sink, excavate or dig any privy vault or cess pool within the corporate limits of the town without having previously obtained a permit in writing so to do from the town marshal or street commissioner; and said vault or cess pool shall not in any case be less than eight feet in depth from the surface of the ground and shall be securely boxed up on the sides and ends so as to effectually prevent the caving of the earth.

Any person violating the provisions of this section shall on conviction be fined in any sum not less than five dollars or more than twenty-five dollars for each offence.
