

**AN ORDINANCE.**

**Annual Appropriation Bill for the  
Fiscal Year Beginning April 1st,  
1888, and Ending March  
31st, A. D. 1889.**

*Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town  
of Grand Junction, Colorado:*

SECTION 1. The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Grand Junction, for the fiscal year beginning April 1st, A. D. 1888, and ending March 31st, A. D. 1889, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars.

2nd. For the purpose of sustaining and improving streets, alleys, crossings and ditches and public parks, two thousand dollars.

3rd. For the purpose of procuring water for irrigating shade trees, lawns and public parks, and for domestic purposes, the sum of four hundred dollars.

4th. For the purpose of lighting the streets, alleys and avenues, the sum of five hundred dollars.

5th. For the general fund, the sum of twenty-three hundred dollars.
