

**An Ordinance Concerning Town
Officers.**

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the
Town of Grand Junction:

SECTION 1. The Recorder shall, before entering
upon the duties of his office, take and subscribe
the oath of office prescribed in Section 2 of Arti-
cle 1 of Chapter III of the Revised Ordinances of
1884, and shall give a bond to the Town of Grand
Junction, with sureties to be approved by the
Board of Trustees, in the penal sum of \$1,500.00,
and conditioned, as provided for the bonds of
other officers in said Section 2.

The oath of office and bond of the Recorder,
when approved, shall be filed with and remain
in the custody of the Town Treasurer.
