

## An Ordinance.

An ordinance concerning Licenses :

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction, Colo.

SECTION 1 The amount of money which shall be paid for liquor licenses shall be as follows, to-wit:

For each retail liquor license, five hundred dollars per annum.

For each wholesale liquor license, fifty dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. No license shall be issued to any person to sell spirituous, vinous, or malt liquors in less quantities than one gallon until the applicant therefor shall have first executed a bond in the penal sum of two thousand dollars, which shall run in the name of the people of the state of Colorado, signed by the applicant and at least two good and sufficient surities, who shall be residents and freeholders of the county of Mesa and State of Colorado; and the said surities on said bond shall justify under oath as to the amount, kind and character of the property that they may own in the said Mesa county, and shall be required to own over and above all exemptions, liabilities and indebtedness, and subject to execution the said sum of two thousand dollars. Said bond shall be conditioned that the applicant shall keep an orderly house; that he will not permit any unlawful gambling or riotous conduct in his house; that he will not violate any of the laws of the State in reference to the selling or giving away of spirituous, vinous or malt liquors, nor violate any of the ordinances of the town of Grand Junction in reference thereto, and that he will pay all damages, fines, or forfeitures which may be adjudged against him for the violation of such laws or ordinances and said bond shall be approved by the Board before the issuance of said license.

SEC. 3 No license shall be issued for a less period than one year, and in no case until the entire amount due therefor has been paid by the applicant to the Town Treasurer.

SEC. 4. Section 1 of an ordinance passed September 14, 1885, concerning licenses be, and the same is hereby repealed.
