An Ordinance.

An ordinance entitled "An ordinance to amend Article 3, of Chapter 5, of the Revised Ordinances of the town of Grand Junction."

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction. Colo.

SECTION 1. That Article 3 of Chapter 5, of the Revised Ordinances of the Town of Grand Junction be, and the same is hereby amended by ad-

ding the following as section eleven (11).

SEC. 11. Whoever shall hinder, obstruct, resist. interrupt or interfere with, or aid encourage, or countenance another person in hindering, obstructing, resisting, interrupting or interfering with any officer of said town in the discharge of his official duties, or shall rescue or shall attempt to rescue from any such officer any person in his custody, or shall prevent or attempt to prevent any such officer from arresting any person, or shall hinder, obstruct, resist, interrupt or interfere with any person called upon or authorized by any such officer to aid him in making an arrest, or to assist him in his official duties, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars for each offence.
