

AN ORDINANCE.

An ordinance fixing the compensation of the Mayor and members of the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction, Colo.

WHEREAS, The question of paying the Mayor and members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction the sum of Five dollars for each regular meeting of said Board during his year, not to exceed the sum of Sixty dollars per year to each member, was submitted to the legal voters of the said Town of Grand Junction on the 1st day of April, A. D. 1890, and

WHEREAS, the said proposition was endorsed, and a majority of the legal voters of said town having voted in favor thereof.

Therefore be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado.

SECTION 1. That hereafter the Mayor and each member of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado, shall receive the sum of Five dollars for each regular meeting of the said Board he shall attend during his term of office, provided the total sum paid to the said Mayor or any member of the said Board shall not exceed the sum of Sixty dollars for any one year during his term of office.
