

**An Ordinance.**

An ordinance granting a right of way to the Western Union Telegraph Company.

*Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction:*

SECTION I. That the right of way for the erection of poles and the management of a telegraph line is hereby given and granted to the Western Union Telegraph Company on, over and across all the streets and alleys in the town of Grand Junction, Colorado. Provided that in the erection or operation of said line by said company it shall not in any way obstruct any street, avenue or alley in said town or interfere in any way with public travel or traffic.
