dividing the Town (City) of Grand Junction into Wards.

Whereas the Secretary of State ,of the State of Colorado has transmitted to the Mayor of the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado, under the provisions of Section 3363 of the General Statutes, a statement showing that the Town of Grand Junction is entitled to be advanced to the grade of a city of the second class, and Whereas the Board of Trustees of said Town deem the change of grade desirable, and to the end that the same may be organized according to its new grade therefore

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction:

Section 1. The division of the city into wards, and the boundaries thereof, shall be as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of said city lying ~~east~~ West of a line running through the center of Fourth Street from its intersection with Main Street and extending South to the Southern boundary line of said ~~Town~~ City, and lying South of a line running through the center of Main Street from its intersection with Fourth Street and extending West to the Western boundary line of said City, shall be designated and known as the First Ward.

All that portion of said City lying North of a line running through the center of Main Street from its intersection with Fifth Street and extending West to the Western boundary line of said City, and lying West of a line running through the center of Fifth Street from its intersection with Main Street and extending North to the Northern boundary line of said City, shall be designated and known as the Second Ward.

All that portion of said City lying North of a line running through the center of Main Street from its intersection with Fifth Street and extending East to the Eastern Boundary line of said City, and lying East of a line running through the center of Fifth Street

from its intersection with Main Street and extending North to the Northern boundary line of said City, shall be designated and known as the Third Ward.

All that portion of said City lying East of a line running through the center of Fourth Street from its intersection with ~~Main Street~~ Main Street and extending South to the Southern boundary line of said City, and lying South of a line running ~~through the center of Main Street~~ through the center of Main Street from its intersection with Fourth Street and extending ~~West~~ East to the boundary line of said City, shall be designated and known as the Fourth Ward.
