

An Ordinance.

An ordinance entitled: The annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1890, and ending March 31, 1891.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction Colorado:

SECTION 1. The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the town of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1890 and ending March 31, 1891, to wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force. Five thousand dollars.

2nd. For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing the parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, ditches and sidewalks, lighting the streets, alleys, and public buildings and providing water for irrigation. Twelve thousand dollars.

3rd. For the purpose of paying hydrant rental. Two thousand dollars.

4th. For the purpose of maintaining a fire department. Fifteen hundred dollars.

5th. For the general fund. Six thousand dollars.

Passed, approved and adopted this 3rd day of March, A. D. 1890.
