An Ordinance Concerning Barber Shops.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction;

Section I. No barber shop shall hereafter be kept open for work or business on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, nor shall the proprietor of any such shop or any employee thereof, pursue, carry on or engage in his or their usual avocation on said day,

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the foregoing section shall on conviction pay a fine of not less than \$5.00

nor more than \$100,00 for each offense.
