## AN ORDINANCE

To authorize the erection, construc-on and operation of a plant or plants r the generation and transmission of light, power the operation manufacture ctricity for lig purpose; for the operation of telephone ines; for the manufacture of ice and refrigerant and the conveyance and transmission of such refrigerant; and for the generation of steam and its convey nee and transmission for heating or power purposes; in the town of Grand Junction, Colorado: urposes,

Le it ordained by the board of trustees of the town of Grand Junction, Colorado:

Section 1. That to J. Trowbridge Eailey and Thomas B. Steams, their heirs, executors, administrators, logal representatives and assigns, be and are hereby granted, subject to the conditions, stipulations and requirement-hereinafter recited, the right and privilege to purchase, construct, operate and maintain a plant or plants, and the necessary equipments, in the town of Grand Junction, for any one or more or all of the following purposes:

For generating electricity for light, power or any other purpose; for operating te ephone lines; for the generation of team for heating or for power; for the manufacture of ice and refrigerant; and for furnishing electric light and power, telephone and electric communication, steam heat and refrigerant, or any one or more or all of them to the inhabitants of said town, and to said town in its corporate capacity whenever it may desire to contract therefor; and for any one or more or all of the said purposes, the said J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Stearns, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns are hereby authorized to purchase, erect, construct and maintain the necessary poles or posts of suitable and safe material, and string the same with wire; to excavate for, construct, lay and maintain such subterranean pipes and conduits a said J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Stearns their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and a signs shall deem necessary, through, as said J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Steams their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns shall deem necessary, through, along or across the streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks and public grounds, now or here fiter existing, of said town, with the necessary wires, poles, lamps and a quaratus for any one or more or all of the purposes aforesaid: Provided, that it is purposed afformed to a fixed work shall be done in such moner, and the said poles, wires, pipes and consuits so arranged as to give to the neople of said town, the least possible inconvenience in the free use and occupancy of such streets, alleys, sidewalks and public grounds, and so as to interfere as little as possible with the laying of gas and water pipes, or the construction. of gas and water pipes, or tion of sewers and drain the cons of gas and water pipes, or the construction of sewers and drains; and all excivations occasioned in doing such work shall be refilled, graded and repaired by said parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, at their own cost and expense, it a good substantial and graded substantials. ministrators, legal representatives and assigns, at their own cost and expense, in a good, substantial and workmanlike manner as soon as practicable under the circumstances. Provided, further, that said parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall be and remain solery and exclusively responsible for all dama, to person or property that may occur by reason of any negligence or unsellillfulness in the carrying on of such thank, or in subsequent remains or changes therein; and said parties, their is exceutors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall hold safe and harmless said Town of Grand Junction in its municipal capacity, from rapresentatives and assigns, shall hold a fe and harmless said Town of Grand Lunction in its municipal capacity, from any and all loss and damage of any and and description, by reason thereof.

Sec. 2. All wires shall be laid in underground conduits or shall be run on poles which shall not be less than eventy feet in height a wore the ground, and not less than four inches in diameter at the smaller end, and such poles shall be constructed and see in such places as the board of trustees, by its committee on streets and a leys, may direct, and the same

and all wires or other apparatus in con-nection therewith, shall be mantain d and kept in repair under the supervis-ion, and to the approval, of said committee.

SEC. 3. The said parties, their heirs execi tors, administrators, legal representa-tives and assigos, shall at all times pro-tect their wires and appliances by such ir sulat on, coating of wires with non-conducting materials and "cut-outs" as are necessary to render the use of such electrical currents safe to life and property within the town, and by all such safeguards as science and experience

be jeguards as stellars and experience my ly demonstrate, will aid thereto.

Sec. 4. Said parties shall at all times be prepared to furnis to said town of Grand Junction and to its inhabitants, a good standard quality of electric light to illumin ting purposes, at a fair and reasonable compensation, and at uniform prices for the same can ile power, a schedule of prices for which shall be filed with the town recorder as soon as established or whenever thereafter or whenever thereafter modified.

Sec. 5. No lamp or wires shall be placed or strung at a height less than eighteen feet above the streets unless the express permission and approval in writing of the committee on streets and alleys shall have first been had and ob-

tained.

SEC. 6. The said parties shall within Sec. 6. The said parties shall within ten days after the passage of this ordinance, file with the town recorder their acceptance in writing of all the terms, con titions, stipulations and provisions hersof, which said acceptance shall, by the town recorder, be recorded in the book of ordinances of this town; and the said parties shall before the 1st day of Desaid par eaid parties shall before the 1st day of De-cember A.D. 1890, begin in good faith the erection and construction of their elec-tric light works, and shall coctinue the prosecution of such work, and commerce the operation thereof within six months from the 31st day of October, A. D. 1893. And if they fail so to do, or in any sab-stantial manner fail to comply with the provisions of this ordinance, such failure shall have the effect of working a forfeiture of the rights and privileges hereby granted them, concerning the erection and operation of such electric light works. And if the said parties shall not within two years after the passage bers-of, complete the construction and com-monce the operation of their works, and plant for the manufacture of ice and the plant for the manufacture of ice and the munifacture and conveyance and transmission of refrigerant, or their works at d plant for the generation and conveyance and transmission of steam for heating and power purposes, or their works and plant for the operation of Tephone lines, then such failure shall have he effect of working a forfeiture of any par icular one of said rights and privileges, concerning which default

shall have been made, namely, of the right and privilege of the manufacture of ice and refrigerant and of its conveyance and transmission, or of the right and privilege of the generation and conveyance of steam for heating or power purposes, or of the right and privilege of operating telephone lines.

Sec. 7. It is hereby expressly provided and declared that no exclusive franchise or privilege is intended to be hereby granted and conferred. This franchise is to exist for the term of twenty years.
