An Ordinance

To authorize the erection, construc-tion and operation of a plant or plants for the generation and transmission of or the generation and transmission of ectricity for light, power or any other purpose, and for the operation of telephone lines; for the manufacture of ice and refrigerant, and the conveyance and transmission of such refrigerant; and for transmission of such refrigerant; and for the generation of steam, and its conveyance and tr usm ssion for heating or power purposes, in the town of Grand Junction, Colorado.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the town of Grand Junction, Colorado:

SECTION I. That to J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Stearns, theil heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and ssigns be and are

heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and ssigns, be and are hereby granted, subject to the conditions, stipulations and requirements hereinafter recited, the right and privilege to purchase construct, operate and maintain a plant or plants and the necessary equipments, in the town of Grand Juuction, for any one, or more, or all of the following purposes:

For generating electricity for light, power or any other purpose; for operating telephone line; for the generation of steam for heating, or for power; for the manufacture of ice and refrigerant; and for furnishing electric light and power, telephone and electric communication, steam heat and refrigerant, or

cation, steam heat and refrigerant, or any one or more, or all of them, to the inhabitants of said town, and to said town in its corporate capacity whenever tit may desire to contract therefor; and for any one or more, or all, of the said purposes, the s id J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Stearns, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, and assigns are hereby atives and assigns, are hereby authorized to purchase, erect, construct and maintain the necessary poles or posts, of suitable and safe material, and string the same with wire; to excavate for, construct, lay and maintain and abstract the same with wire and abstract the same with t maintain such ubterranean piles and conduis, as said J. Trowbridge Bailey and Thomas B. Stearns, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall deem necessant the said assigns, shall deem necessant the said assigns, shall deem necessant the said assigns. sentatives and assigns, shall deem necessary, through, along or accross the streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks and public grounds, now or hereinafter existing, of said town, with the necessary wires, poles, lamps and apparatus, for any one or more or al of the purposes aforesaid: Provided, that all such work shall be done in such manner, and the sid poles, wires, pipes and confutts so arranged as to give to the people of said town the least possible inconveninger. town the least possible inconvenience in the free use and occupency of such streets, alleys, sidewalks and public grounds, and so as to interfere as little as possible with the laying of gas and water pipes, or the construction of sewers and drains; and all excavations in doing such work shall be renilled, graded and r paired by said parties, their heirs, execut rs, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, at their own cost and expense, in a good, substantial and workmanlike manner as soon as procticable under the circumstances. Provided furthe, that said porties, their neirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall be aud remain solely and exclusively responsible for all damage to person or property that may occur by reason of any negligence or unskillfulness in the carrying on of such work, or in subsequent repairs and changes therein: and said parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall hold safe and harmless said town of Grand Junction, in its municipal capacity, from any and all damage of any kind and deand r. paired by said parties, their heirs, municipal capacity, from any and all loss and damage of any kind and description, by reason thereof

All wires shall be laid SECTION 11. Section II. All wires shall be laid in under ground conduits, or shall be run on poles which shall not be less than twenty feet in height above the ground, and not less than four inches in diameter at the smaller end; and such poleshall be constructed and set in such places as the board of trustee, by its committee on streets and alleys, may direct, and the same and all wires or other apparatusin connection therewith. other apparatus in connection therewith, shall be m intained and kept in repair

shall be montained and kept in repair under the supervision and to the ap-proval of said committee. Section III. The said parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, shall at all times protect their wires and appliances by such insulation, coating of wires with non-conducting materials and "cut-outs" as are necessary to render the use of such electrical currents safe to life and property within the town, and by all such safe-guards as a lence and ex-perience may demonstrate will aid perience may

thereto.

SECTION IV. Said parties shall at all times be prepared to furnish to said town of Grand Junction, and to its in-babitants, a good standar i quality of electric light for illum nating purposes, at a fair and reasonable compensation and at uniform prices for the same candle power, a schedule of prices for which shall be filed with the town recorder, as

soon as established or whenever there-

after modified.

Section V. No lamp or wires shall be placed or strung at a height less than eighteen feet above the streets, unless the express permission and approval of

the committee on streets and alleys shall have first been had and obtained.

Section VI. The said parties stall, within ten days after the passage of this ordinance, file with the town recorder their acceptance in writing of all the terms, conditions, stipulations and provisions thereof, which said acceptance shall by the recorder be recorded in the book of ordinances recorded in the book of ordinances of this town; and they shall, within thirty days after the passage hereof, begin in good faith the erection and construction of their said electric light works, and shall di igently continue the prosecution of such work and complete the same, and commence the operation thereof within six months after the passage begon by the same and complete within six months after the passage begon by the same and complete within six months after the passage begon by the same and complete within six months after the passage begon by the same and the s age hereof; and shall, within two years after the passage hereof, complete and commence the operation of all of their other works, the right to construct and

Any failure of said parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal repre-entatives and as igns, to comply with the terms, conditions and stipulations of this ordinance, as to any of said tranchises shall have the effect to work a forfeiture of such right, privilege, or framphise conferred. effect to work a forfeiture of such right, privilege or franchise conferred or granted hereby, and concerning which such default shall have been made; and it is hereby expressly provided and declared that no exclusive franchise craptivilege is intended to be granted and conferred hereby.
