

The annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1891, and ending March 31, 1892.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction, Colorado:

The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1891, and ending March 31, 1892, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force, thirty five hundred dollars.

2d. For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing ~~the~~ the parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, ditches and sidewalks, lighting the streets, alleys and public buildings, and providing water for irrigation, twelve thousand dollars.

3d. For the purpose of paying hydrant rental, \$2,500⁰⁰ dollars

4th. For the purpose of maintaining a fire department, two thousand (2000) dollars.

5th. For the purpose of paying ~~the~~ fees and salaries other than police officers, thirty five hundred dollars.

6th. For the general fund five thousand dollars.
