

Concerning Fees and Salaries.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction:

Section 1. The several officers and employees of the City of Grand Junction, hereinafter designated, shall receive the following compensation, to-wit:

Sec. 2. The Mayor shall receive ^(600⁰⁰) sixty dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec. 3. Each Alderman shall receive ^(600⁰⁰) sixty dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec. 4. The City Marshall shall receive ^(1200⁰⁰) twelve hundred dollars per year payable monthly, together with all legal fees due by virtue of arrests made or process served by him under any ordinance of the City and other fees due him by virtue of any proceeding under said ordinances. Provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec. 5. Each Policeman shall receive ^(900⁰⁰) 900⁰⁰ dollars per year payable monthly, together with the same fees as those of the Marshall for like services.

Sec. 6. The Street Commissioner shall receive ^(900⁰⁰) 900⁰⁰ dollars per year payable monthly, and such fees as may be provided by ordinance; provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec. 7. The City Treasurer shall receive ^(300⁰⁰) 300⁰⁰ dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec. 8. The City Clerk shall receive ^(420⁰⁰) 420⁰⁰ dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec. 9. The Police Magistrate shall receive ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ the same fees or compensation as are now, or may hereafter be, provided by law for Justices of the Peace, for like services in the County of Mesa; provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec. 10. The City Attorney shall receive ^(600⁰⁰) 600⁰⁰ dollars per year, payable monthly. And there shall be allowed to him and


taxed with the costs in the Justice's or Police Magistrates Court,
a fee of five dollars, and in a court of record a fee of ten dollars
for each day that he appears in any case in such Courts respective-
ly: provided ~~the City~~ that in the prosecution of suits for fines and penalties
such fees shall not be paid by the city.


Sec.11. The City Engineer shall receive reasonable ~~amkkrxx~~
compensation for services actually performed by him, in accordance
with any order or resolution or ordinance of the City Council; and x
such fees as are prescribed by ordinance.

Sec.12. The City Printer shall receive such compensation as
may be agreed upon at the beginning of each fiscal year.
