Concerning Fees and Salaries.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Junction:

Section 1. The several officers and employees of the City of Grand Junction, hereinafter designated, shall receive the following compensation, to-wit:

Sec. 2. The Mayor shall receive anty dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec. 3. Each Alderman shall receive sixty dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec.4. The City Marshall shall receive with all legal fees due by virtue of arrests made or process served by him under any ordinance of the City and other fees due him by virtue of any proceeding under said ordinances. Provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec. 5. Each Policeman shall receive 1900 dollars per year payable monthly, together with the same fees as those of the Marshala for like services.

Sec. 6. The Street Commissioner shall receive 900 dollars per year payable monthly, and such fees as may be provided by ordinance; provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec.7. The City Treasurer shall receive 43000 dollars per year payable monthly.

Sec.8. The City Clerk shall receive \$\frac{4420}{420}\text{dollars per} year payable monthly.

Sec. 9. The Police Magistrate shall receive MANNAGARAGA the same fees or compensation as are now, or may hereafter be, provided by law for Justices of the Peace, for like services in the County of Mesa; provided that no such fees shall be paid by the City.

Sec. 10. The City Attorney shall receive 1600 dollars per year, payable monthly. And there shall be allowed to him and

a fee of five dollars, and in a court of record a fee of ten dollars for each day that he appears in any case in such Courts respectively: provided that in the prosecution of suits for fines and penaltics such fees shall not be paid by the city.

Sec. 11. The City Engineer shall receive reasonable dokkarax compensation for services actually performed by him, in accordance with any order or resolution or ordinance of the City Council; and a such fees as are prescribed by ordinance.

Sec.12. The City Printer shall receive such compensationas may be agreed upon at the begining of each fiscal year.
