

## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.

Annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1893, and ending March 31, 1894.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado:

That the following sums of money be and the same hereby are appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1893, and ending March 31, 1894, to-wit:

First.—For the purpose of maintaining the fire department, seven hundred and fifty dollars.

Second.—For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing streets, alleys, parks, avenues, sidewalks, crossings and ditches, lighting streets, public buildings and alleys and providing water for irrigation purposes, six thousand dollars.

Third.—For the purpose of maintaining police officers, twenty-five hundred dollars.

Fourth.—For the purpose of paying fees and salaries of city officials other than the police force, three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars.

Fifth.—For the general fund, six thousand five hundred dollars.

Passed and approved by the city council of the city of grand Junction, Colorado, the twenty-eighth day of February, 1893.
