

AN ORDINANCE.

*Mayor*

Annual Appropriation Bill, for the Fiscal Year Beginning April 1st, 1892, and Ending March 31st, 1893.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado.

The following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado for the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1892, and ending March 31st 1893, to-wit:

First, For the purpose of sustaining a police force, three thousand dollars.

Second, For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing, parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, ditches and sidewalks, lighting streets, alleys and public buildings, and providing water for irrigation, eight thousand dollars.

Third, For the purpose of paying hydrant rental, twenty-five hundred dollars.

Fourth, For the purpose of maintaining a fire department, one thousand dollars.

Fifth, For the purpose of paying fees and salaries, other than of police officers, twenty-five hundred dollars.

Sixth, For the general fund, eight thousand dollars.
