ORDINANCE NO. 4.

An Ordinance Concerning Finance.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

SEC. 1 — The fiscal year of the City of Grand Junction shall commence on the first day of April in each year.

SEC. 2 — All bills against the City shall be presented in the form of an itemized account, stating specifically the nature of the indebtedness, and shall be sworn to by the claimant or his agent. The affidavit may be in the following form:

I, A. B.,—, on oath state that the foregoing account is just and due, and no portion thereof has been paid, and that it comprises all claims I have against the City of Grand Junction to date.

All such bills shall be read to the City Council in open session, and either referred to committees, or otherwise disposed of as may be deemed proper.
