

## ORDINANCE NO. 21.

*An Ordinance Repealing Certain Ordinances.*

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the city of Grand Junction;

SECTION 1. All of the ordinances of the town and city of Grand Junction, passed and adopted prior to the 26th day of September, A. D. 1891, save and except such ordinances as purport to grant or convey franchises or rights of way, be and the same are hereby repealed; provided, that the repeal of said ordinances shall not affect any act done or any right accruing, accrued or established, or any suit, or proceeding had or commenced in any cause before the time when said repeal shall take effect, nor any offense committed, nor any penalty or forfeiture incurred, nor any suit or prosecution pending at the time of such repeal for any offense committed or for the recovery of any forfeiture or penalty incurred under any of the ordinances so repealed.
