Ordinance No 23.

An ordinance entitled an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 11 of the revised ordinances of the city of Grand Junction.

Section 1. The city attorney shall receive a salary of three hundred dollars per year, and there shall be allowed to him and taxed with the costs in the justice's or police magistrate's office, a fee of five dollars, and in a court of record a fee of ten dollars for each day he appears in any case in such courts respectively; provided, that in the prosecution of suits for fines and penalties such fees shall not be paid by the city.

Section 2. Section 4 of article II and section 5 of article III of ordinance No. 11, be and the same are hereby repealed.
