

ORDINANCE NUMBER 24.

An ordinance amending section 3 of article 5 of an ordinance entitled "an ordinance concerning streets, avenues, alleys and public grounds."

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Grand Junction: That

SECTION 3 of article 5 of ordinance number 17 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

SEC. 3. The buildings fronting on all streets shall be numbered by plain, distinct figures, not less than two inches in length, placed upon some conspicuous portion of the front of such buildings. Such numbers to be as follows, to-wit: Commencing with Main street, on all streets running north and south therefrom, the first number shall be 100, and so commencing they shall be consecutively numbered until the terminus of the block. The first numbering of the second block shall commence with number 200 and so consecutively carried forward to the end of the block. All the residue of the blocks extending north or south shall be so numbered, commencing with consecutive hundreds for each additional block to the limits of the city, as the same now is, or may hereafter be constituted and laid out. The even numbers shall be on the east side and the odd numbers on the west side of all streets running north and south. On all streets running east and west from First street, the first numbering shall be 100, as hereinbefore designated, for the first block, and consecutive hundreds for each additional block to the limits of the city, as the same now is or may hereafter be constituted and laid out. On all streets running east and west the even numbers shall be on the north side and the odd numbers on the south side thereof. Twelve and one-half feet frontage shall be given to each number on all streets.
