ORDINANCE No. 26.

An ordinance to amend sections two (2), five (5) and six (6) of article two of Ordinance No. Eleven of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado, passed and approved September 26, 1892,3 the same being an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Concerning City Officers."

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado.

Section 1.—That section two (2) of article two of said ordinance No. eleven he and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "The mayor \$180.00."

Sec. 2.—That section five (5) of said article two of said ordinance No. eleven be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 5.- The

city clerk \$300.00."

Sec. 3.—That section six (6) of said article two of said ordinance No. eleven be and the same is hereby amended so "The city marshal as to read as follows: \$1080.00 together with all legal fees due by virtue of arrests made or process served by him under any ordinance of the city, and other fees due him by virtue of and thereunder, such fees to be the same as now are or may hereafter be provided by law for constables for like services in the county of Mesa, provided that no such fees shall be paid by the city.
