

ORDINANCE NO. 28.

An Ordinance Concerning Passenger Depots and the Selling of Milk, Bread, Cake, Pie, Meat, Lunch or Refreshments at Same.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

Section 1. No person shall be permitted or allowed to go upon the platform of or into any passenger railroad depot within this city or within thirty-five feet of any such platform, railroad track or depot for the purpose of soliciting railroad passengers or other persons to purchase any milk, bread, cake, pie, meat, lunch or refreshments.

Section 2. No person shall sell or offer for sale upon any platform of or within any passenger railroad depot within this city or within thirty-five feet of any such platform, or railroad track or depot, any milk, bread, cake, pie, meat, lunch or refreshment; Provided, That nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prohibit or prevent any person who owns, manages or who is the proprietor of any eating house or hotel at any such railroad depot from selling milk, bread, cake, pie, meat, lunches or refreshments within said eating house or hotel to passengers or other persons who may go into any such eating house or hotel to purchase milk, bread, cake, pie, meat, lunches or other refreshments.

Section 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, on conviction, be fined in a sum of not less than \$2 00 nor more than \$100.00.
