ORDINANCE No. 3/

a Ordinance to authorize the erection, construction and operation of a system or systems of telephone lines, fire alarm telepraph lines, electric burglar alarm lines, district messenger service lines and the construction and operation of similar electric contrivances, executive. electric contrivances, excepting electric light.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Grand Junction:

Sec. 1. That William P. Clarke and Charles R. Williams, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns, be and hereby are granted, subject to the conditions, sipulations and requirements hereinafter recited, the right and privilege, to purchase construct, operate and maintain a system construct, operate and maintain a system of the adoption of the and privilege, to purchase construct, operate and maintain a system of the adoption of the following purposes:

For the operating telephone lines for operating fire alaim telegraph lines: for operating of similar electric contrivances excepting electric hight. And Jor anyone or more of all said purposes the said William P. Clarke and charles it. Wifflams, their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns are hereby authorized to purchase, effect, construct and maintain the necessary boies or posts of suitable and safe material, and string the same with wire, through, along or across the streets, avenues, allegs, sidewalks and public grounds now or hereinafter existing, of said city, with the necessary wires, poles and apparatus of anyone or more of the purposes aforesaid. Provided that all such work shall be done in such manner and the sand poles and wires so arranged as to give the people of said city the least possible inconvience and the irre use and occupancy of such streets, alleys, sidewalks and public grounds and so as to interfere as fittle as possible with the laying of gas and water pipes, or the construction of sewers and drains; and all excavations occasioned by the doing of said work shall be refilled, graded and repaired by said parties, their ners, executors and assigns, at their own cest and expense, in a good, tubs antial aid workmanlike and manner as soon as practicable under the erremished for the repaired of the formal privales and assigns shall be ano remain socily and executors, legal representatives and assigns shall be another the transparent and shall possible for an annual formatical privaled

Sec. 6. In consideration of the granting of the above ordinance the said W. P. Clarke and Charles R. Williams, their heirs and assigns, agree to furnish the said City of Grand Junction, one telephone, free of charge, for each hose house or fire department building, as now used or may hereafter be established, but said telephones shall only be for use in the case of fire and the use of the said members of the fire department as such.
