

ORDINANCE NO. 31.

Annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year, beginning April 1st, 1894, and ending March 31st, 1895.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo.

Section 1. That the following sums of money be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year, beginning the 1st, day of April, 1894, and ending the 31st day of March 1895, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of sustaining a police force, seventeen hundred dollars.

2nd. For the purpose of maintaining a fire department, five hundred dollars.

3rd. For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, ditches and sidewalks, lighting streets, alleys and public buildings, and providing water for irrigation purposes, five thousand dollars.

4th. For the purpose of paying fees and salaries other than police officers, three thousand and fifty dollars.

5th. For the general fund, three thousand dollars.
