

ORDINANCE NO. 33.

An ordinance amending Section 3, of Ordinance No. 1, of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, passed and approved September 26th, 1891, the same being an ordinance concerning animals running at large.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

Section 1. That Section 3, of Ordinance No. 1, of said city be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 3. The officer taking up stock under the provisions of this ordinance shall collect the following fees and expenses for the city, which said fees and expenses shall be paid by said officer forthwith into the general fund of the City Treasury of said city: For taking up each horse, mule, ass, bull, cow, ox or calf, and placing the same in the pound or other place of safe keeping, \$1.00 and 50 cents for each day such animal shall be kept therein. For every head of swine, sheep, goats ~~and~~ geese so taken up, 50 cents and 25 cents for each day they are kept therein. For writing and posting notices \$1.00. For making affidavit 25 cents. For service of warrant, subpoena and attendance upon court, the usual fees of constables in Mesa county for like services, and in addition thereto the usual cost of advertisement for sale.
