

ORDINANCE NO. 40,

An ordinance concerning salaries and fees of City Attorney, Mayor and Aldermen.

SECTION 1. The City Attorney shall receive a salary of six hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly, and there shall be allowed to him and taxed with the costs in cases in the police magistrates', or justices' courts, a fee of five dollars, for each day he appears in any such case; provided, that such fees shall in no event be taxed against or collected from the city.

SEC. 2. The Mayor shall receive a salary of twenty dollars per month.

SEC. 3. Each alderman shall receive a salary of ten dollars per month.
