

ORDINANCE NO. 41.

The annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year, beginning April 1st, 1895, and ending March 31, 1896.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado.

SECTION 1. The following sums of money be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning the first day of April A. D. 1895, and ending the 31st day of March A. D. 1896, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of maintaining a police force, two thousand dollars.

2nd. For the purpose of maintaining a fire department, seven hundred and fifty dollars.

3rd. For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, ditches and sidewalks, lighting streets, alleys and public buildings, and providing water for irrigation purposes, nine thousand dollars.

4th. For the purpose of paying fees and salaries other than those of police officers, three thousand eight hundred and ten dollars.

5th. For the general fund, six thousand dollars.

Passed, approved and adopted this 26th day of March A. D. 1895.
